Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. What is "The Spiritual Eloquence National Open Oratory Contest"?

The Spiritual Eloquence is a National Open Oratory Contest organized by Dhyan-Kaksh (School of Equanimity & Even-Sightedness) in collaboration with Satyug Darshan Sangeet Kala Kendra and Humanity Development Club. 2. Who can participate in the contest?

The contest is open to participants in the following categories:

- Ankur (Category 1): Students in classes 6th to 8th
- Pushp (Category 2): Students in classes 9th to 12th

- Darakhht (Open Category): Individuals aged 24 years and above

3. Can students participate in the Open Category (Darakhht)?

No, students participating in Categories 1, 2, or 3 are not eligible to participate in the Open Category.

4. What are the prizes for the contest?

At the National Level, the following cash prizes will be awarded in each category:

• **2nd Prize:** ₹5,100

• **3rd Prize**: ₹2,100

• State-Level Results: 25th September 2024

National Level Final Contest: 2nd October 2024

6. How can I submit my application for the contest?

7. What are the guidelines for the speech content?

Participants must select their speech topics from the prescribed PDF or booklets available on the Dhyan-Kaksh website (www.Dhyankaksh.org). The speech must be memorized, and the use of notes or reading material during the presentation is not allowed.

8. What is the evaluation criteria for the contest?

Participants will be evaluated based on:

- Content and Context
- Innovative Ideas
- Communication/Oratory Skills
- Presentation Skills/Engagement
- Clarity of Ideas and Thoughts
- Confidence Level

9. Will there be any judges for the contest?

Yes, a panel of three distinguished judges with expertise in fields such as education, history, social work, and media will evaluate participants' performances at all levels of the contest.

10. Is there any registration fee for the contest?

No, there is no registration fee for participating in the contest at any level.
